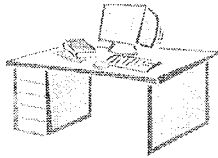

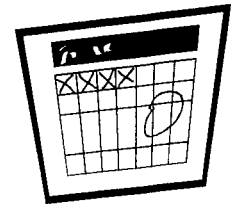

REMINDERS!!!

ASBESTOS: Aries Consulting Group conducted our Three Year asbestos re-inspection for Blessed Sacrament School on August 24, 2015. Most of the asbestos containing materials were removed as part of our major school renovation that took place in the spring and summer of 2005. The remaining known asbestos exists in the exterior soffits and southeast exterior foyer. Any remaining asbestos materials are classified in good condition and have not changed since our last three year inspection. This notice is for your information which is required by state law. We have complied with all LEA rules and responsibilities under Illinois 763.84. We conduct regularly scheduled six month inspections as required. Aries Consulting is approved by the state of Illinois to conduct asbestos work. The operation and management plan for our school is on file and can be reviewed by appointment.

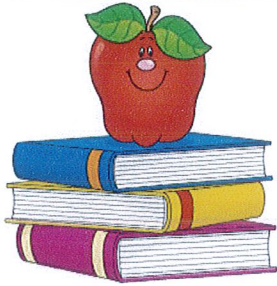

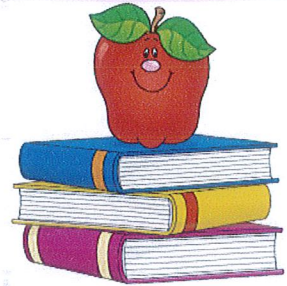
